The works will be published in Volume IV of the Science and Technological Innovation Collection. The book will be co-published with Opuntia Brava magazine and indexed in the following databases: Scopus, EBSCO, DOAJ, MIAR, Cite Factor, Portal de Portales de Latindex, REDIB, WorldCat, Ingenta, COBISS, ResearchBib, ROAD, BASE, Toronto Public Library. University of Oxford, SUNCAT, Discover, Queen Mary University, current Iberoamerican affairs and SJIF Journal Rank.

Rules for the presentation of papers:

Title (sustained and justified capital letter), authors (without placing the term and to the right accompanied by their mail), abstract, key words and introduction (sustained capital letter only the term and justified), development (the term is not written, but subtitles summarizing the essential ideas), conclusions and references (sustained capital letter only the term and justified) and annexes (if necessary).

Length: from 7 to 10 pages (including graphics, tables, footnotes, references and annexes). Authors should use Letter size pages, with single spacing, 6.0 points between paragraphs, in Arial 12.0 type and margins of 2.5 cm. The title should not exceed 20 words (Spanish and English). The abstract should contain the synthesis of the main results, methods and conclusions, without exceeding 250 words (Spanish and English). Keywords: between three and five (Spanish and English).

The footnotes will be in Arial 10.0 points. They should be explanatory and should not be used to indicate the bibliographic sources. In order to quote authors, use references in the body of the paper and elaborate the list of references, the APA6 standard must be used; therefore, only the cited and referenced will be included.

Illustrations (maps, tables, graphs and photos) may be included only when they are strictly necessary. They should be self-explanatory and will be placed at the moment they are alluded to within the text. They may not exceed a width of 12.5 cm and a length of 18.6 cm.

The submission of papers for evaluation will be until January 29, 2019. The official notification of acceptance will be sent from 15 and until March 30, 2019.
